TYPES OF BOOTHS:

INLINE BOOTH: A booth next to other booths in a row.



CORNER BOOTH: A booth on the corner of a row and has two sides open to the aisles. Corner booth will be open to the aisle and will not have 3 ft high drape on the aisle.



BOOTH SPECIFICATIONS

Each booth type comes with:

- 8' x 12' White pipe and drape booth with 8' high white back drape wall & 3' high white side drape, except corner booths which will be open to the aisle.
- One (1) 4' white draped table
- Two (2) Limerick chairs by Herman Miller
- 7" x 44" booth identification sign with the company name and booth number
- Gray booth carpet
- One wastebasket

Hanging Signs

If you have a custom display, you will NOT be provided with a booth aisle sign. No banners and/or signage will be hung in or above a booth unless it has been incorporated into an approved sponsorship agreement with Show Management.

Fire & Storage Regulations:

For safety, do not store cartons, packing materials, or boxes behind drapes, under tables, or near electrical outlets/wiring. A limited supply may be kept neatly in your booth if it does not block utilities, create hazards, or look unsightly. All booth materials must be flame retardant, items (including chairs) must stay out of aisles, and exhibitors may not hang their own lighting. Accessible storage will be available onsite.

Structural Integrity

All exhibit displays should be designed and erected in a manner that will withstand normal contact or vibration caused by neighboring exhibitors, hall laborers, or installation/dismantling equipment, such as forklifts. Exhibitors should ensure that any display fixtures such as tables, racks, or shelves are designed and installed properly to support products to be displayed.
